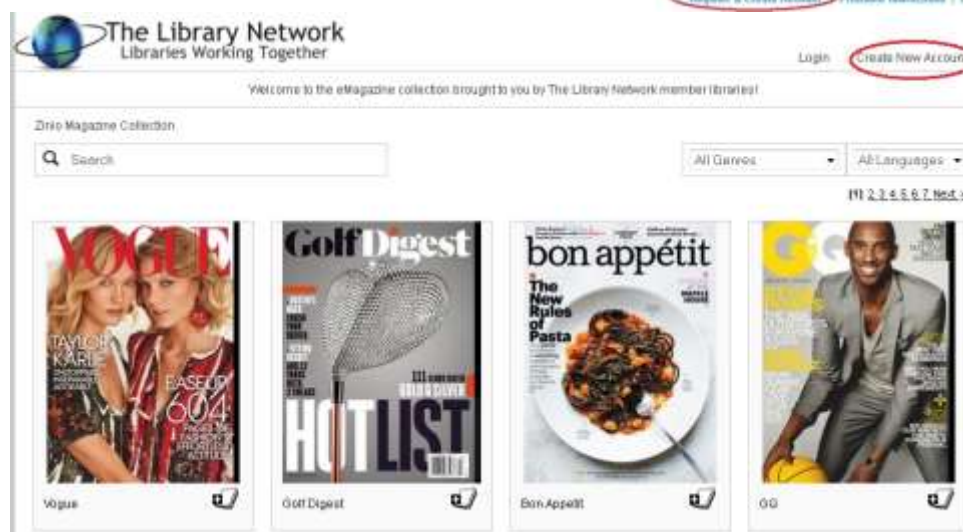

Create a Zinio for Libraries Account and Browse

On your computer or in your tablet or phone's web browser, go to **ebranch.rhpl.org**. Here you'll find more information about Zinio for libraries magazines. Click on **RBdigital Magazines** then **Rbdigital Login**.

1. At the top right of The Library Network screen, click on **Create New Account**. Enter your **library card number** in the box that appears.
2. Click or tap the **Create New Account** button, enter your name and email address and create a Zinio for libraries password.



You are now logged into the RHPL Zinio for Libraries digital magazine site and can read all of the magazines you see in the site.

Once you find a magazine you'd like to read:

1. Click or tap on the add button and then click or tap **Start Reading** to read the magazine right away
2. OR click or tap on the cover to read a description of the magazine or view back issues and select an older issue to read.

A new tab will open on your internet browser and you can read the magazine in this tab on your PC or Mac. *(Please note: to read magazines on your tablet you will need to download a separate **Zinio for Libraries** app)*



Read Your Magazines

Note: You must first browse for and download magazines using a web browser on your computer or mobile device.

Computer users - Zinio for Libraries is available for use entirely in your internet web browser.

Compatible with PC—Internet Explorer 10+, Chrome, and Firefox

Compatible with Mac—Safari, Chrome, and Firefox

Kindle Fire HD/HDX

Download the **Zinio for Libraries** app from your device's App Store to your device to read your magazines. The **Zinio for Libraries** app is not available for 1st or 2nd generation Kindle Fires.

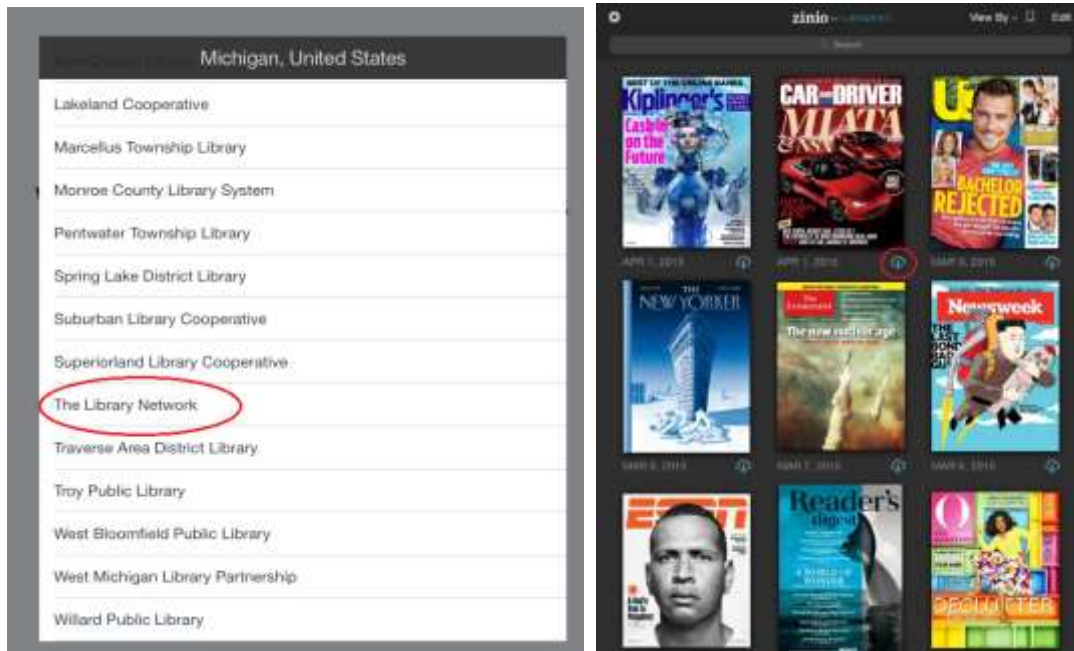
Android & iOS Users

Please note: If you attempt to read the magazine within the internet browser on your tablet, you will receive a message that you need to update Adobe Flash on your device. *All Zinio magazines must be read in the Zinio for Libraries app on your tablet.*



Go to your device's store (App Store, Google Play, etc.). Search for **Zinio for Libraries**. Download the **Zinio for Libraries** app. The Zinio for Libraries app is different from the plain Zinio app. Make sure you get the one for libraries.

Login by selecting your country, state and library (**The Library Network**).



All of the magazines you have previously checked out in your web browser will be available. Tap on a cover to read and download a magazine. Any magazine with a cloud icon in the bottom right corner has not yet been downloaded and will not be available to read unless you are connected to the internet.

Additional Notes

- At this time, it is not possible to automatically subscribe to a magazine with RHPL's Zinio for Libraries magazine service. You can, however, sign up for email alerts when a new issue of your favorite magazine is available. You'll receive one email a week with a list of your magazines that are updated and ready to check out.
- There is no limit to the number of magazines you can download and enjoy from RHPL's Zinio for Libraries magazine service.
- Digital magazines that you download through RHPL's Zinio for Libraries magazine service will never expire. If you delete a magazine, it can always be retrieved within your account.
