We dedicate this issue of our publication to Mr. E. D. Kennedy, our superintendent.

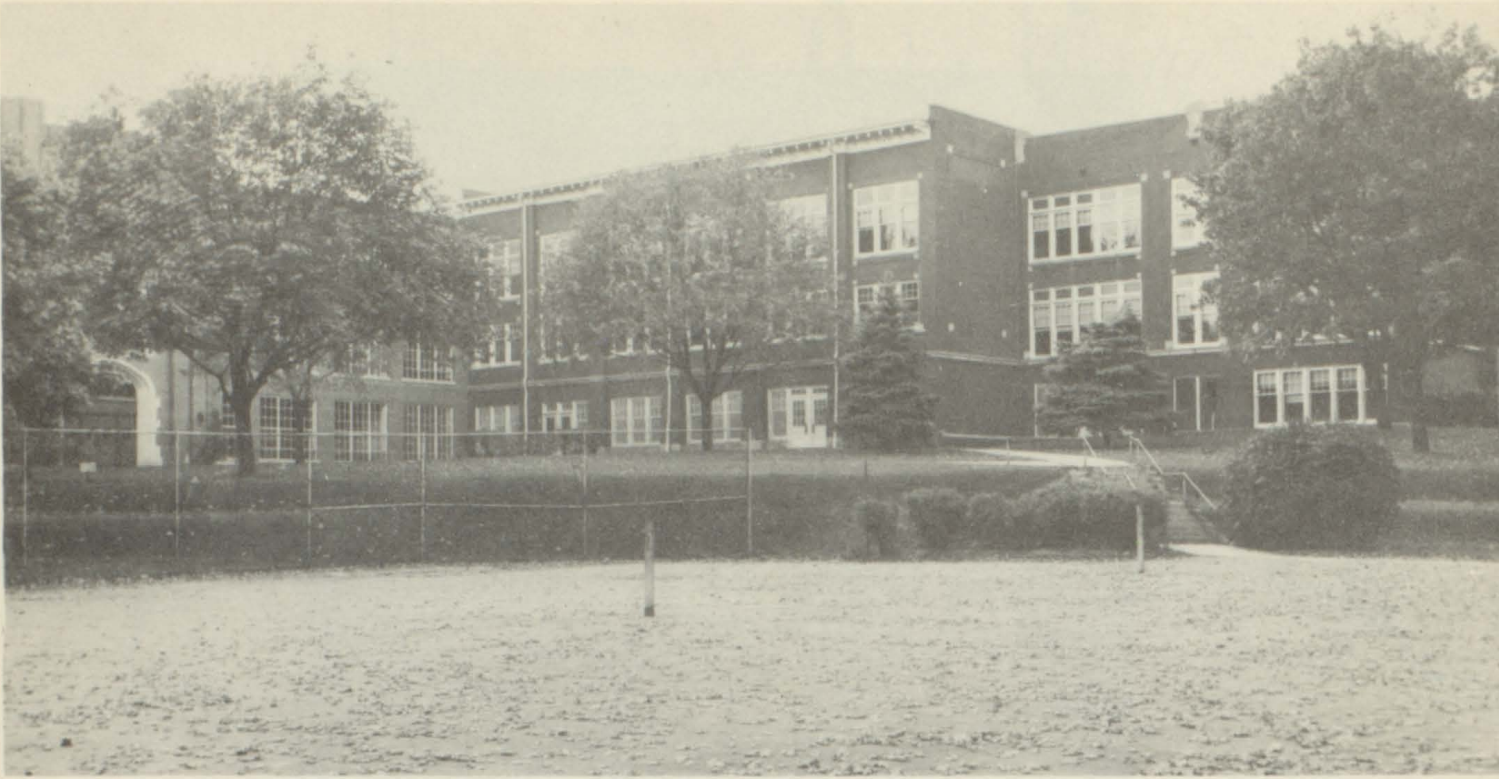

He has given freely of his best, and the lives of hundreds of people who came under his guidance are richer because of him. To the school and the community he has left a real heritage.

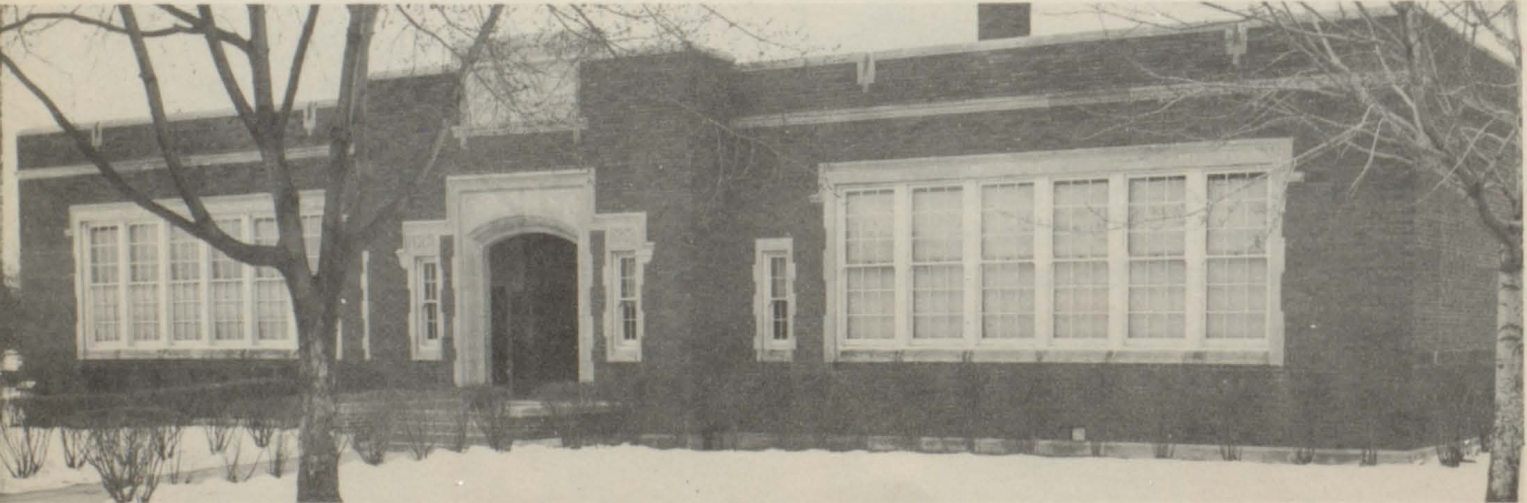
His influence will be long lasting. It may well be said that his personality has lighted many candles which in later years will shine back to cheer him.
