 - Only two books can be checked out at a time
 - Books check out for two weeks with one renewal



4 Months

- November 15 March 9
- Register by Saturday, February 10 in the Youth Services
 Department
 - Teams must have a coach before registering
 - There is no cap on registration
 - RHPL library cards are required for registration
- The Battle is on Saturday, March 9 at 2:00 pm in the Hart MS gymnasium
- The awards ceremony is on Monday, March 11 at 6:00 pm in the Hart MS gymnasium



1 Competition

- Hart MS gymnasium
 - 50 questions based on 12 books
 - Title and author
 - Teams have 30 seconds to answer each question
 - We provide answer sheets and pencils
 - Some confidence boosters
- Scoring
 - 2 possible points for every answer
 - The important thing is that your 5th grader has fun!
- Awards ceremony




